

2018_05_12 Scilly Porthcressa Bay Panorama

A short description: this is a 300x30cm drawing, made with brush and Chinese ink. It shows a roughly 300 degrees round view standing on the left side of Porthcressa bay, showing from left to right the coast of St. Mary's, some rocks in the middle of the bay (tide was low), a quick glance on the Scillonian, Garrison Hill and Hugh Town, ending on the right side on some large rocks. It was made with a hand-held, portable scrolling board (see the pictures below) in a continuous fashion, rolling and slowly turning in one session of a few hours. Since I'm left handed and every leftie knows the disaster of wiping the just-written with your own hand,, the drawing was actually made working from right to left .
